SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Rights of Public Entity

The Oshikoto Regional Council reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, or
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation; and
- (c) to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the items mentioned in Section III by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) The Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Securing Declaration
- (b) The List of Goods and Price Schedule Section III;
- (c) The Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- (d) Any other attachment deemed appropriate.

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Sealed Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The Quotation validity period shall be 90 days from the date of submission deadline.

5. Bid Securing Declaration

Bidders are required to subscribe to a Bid Securing Declaration for this procurement process. The Bidder shall furnish as part of its quotation, a Bid Security as per the format contained in Appendix to Quotation Letter of this document for an amount of NAD based on 2% of your budget estimate for the procurement validity period of bid security must be 30 days beyond the quotation validity period.

6. Services Completion Period

The completion period for works shall be **30 days**, after acceptance / issuing of the Purchase Order and Claim Form. Deviation in completion period shall not be accepted/shall be considered if such deviation is reasonable.

7. Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the Oshikoto Regional Council-Directorate of Education, Arts and Culture with the Bidder's name at the back of the envelope.

8. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be deposited in the Quotation/Bid Box located at Bid Box located at Ground Floor, ORC Head Office in Omuthiya, on or before Tuesday, 25 February 2025, before 11h00.Oshikoto Regional Council, Office, Quotations by post or hand delivered should reach the above address, before the closing date and time. Late quotations will be rejected. Quotations received by fax or e-mail will not be considered.

9. Opening of Bids

The Public Entity will open quotations internally immediately after the closing time referred to in section 8 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted and the presences of Obligatory documents will be made available to any bidder on request within three working days after the Opening.

10. Evaluation of Bids

The Public Entity shall have the right to request for clarifications during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of evaluated cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

11. Technical Compliance

The Specifications and Compliance Sheet details the minimum specifications of the works to be carried out. The specifications have to be met, but no credit will be given for exceeding the specifications.

12. Prices and Currency of Payment

Prices for the execution of services shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars as quoted. Quotations shall cover all costs of labour, materials, equipment, overheads, profits and all associated costs for performing the services, and shall include all duties. The whole cost of performing the services shall be included in the items stated, and the cost of any incidental services shall be deemed to be included in the prices quoted.

13. Award of Contract

The Bidder having submitted the lowest evaluated responsive quotation and qualified to perfume the works shall be selected for award of contract. Award of contract shall be by issue of a Letter of Acceptance in accordance with terms and conditions contained in Section VI: Contract Agreement and General Conditions of Contract. NB: Council Reserved Right to award the bid as whole to one bidder or per Lot to multiple bidders.

14. Notification of Award and Debriefing
